ARCHITECT Curtis Miner Architecture **BACKGROUND:** Canyons District's Willow Canyon Elementary School is located in Sandy, Utah. Motivated by research showing how natural light is critical for the productivity and well-being of students, faculty and staff, the Canyons Board of Education proposed a tax-rate-neutral bond that, among other things, would be used to add natural daylight to multiple elementary schools in all corners of the District, including Willow Canyon Elementary.

**CHALLENGE:** After adding daylight to their first school, the District quickly learned that not all tubular daylighting devices are created equal. The first product used did not live up to the District's expectations for light quality and performance.
