Solatube® Brighten Up® Series Rooftop Fire Glazing

1 Remove tube clips and dome ring from top tube. Remove tube ring and set aside for later use.

2 Install provided metal clips into notches on top tube. Pull up on clip and apply foil tape to secure.

3 Insert Top Tube and Rooftop Fire Glazing

Insert top tube into flashing

Latch clips over flashing

Insert rooftop fire glazing into flashing and top tube

Insert tube ring on top fire glazing and flashing

Fasten to flashing with dome screws (provided with dome fastener kit)

Dome screw

Complete installation process, including dome and tube installation per Solatube Brighten Up Series Installation Instructions P/N: 951780.
Please Note: The Solatube Rooftop Fire Glazing must be used in conjunction with the Solatube Dome Edge Protection Band to meet the prescriptive method of option 1 of IBC 708A.2.1.
 If local jurisdiction official needs assistance in understanding prescriptive acceptance, please contact Cal Fire or your Office of the State Fire Marshal as they can step them through the prescriptive process.
